

How to draw a histogram in Minitab

There are two ways to draw a histogram in Minitab. The easier method does not allow as fine control of the final plot as the more complicated method.

Easier method.

The easier method is similar to the way of drawing a boxplot. First select the **S**tat menu and then **B**asic Statistics and then **D**isplay Descriptive Statistics....

In the dialogue box which now appears the column 'Ques1' in the left hand window should be double-clicked, so that 'Ques1' appears in the **V**ariables: box.

You should now click on the **G**raphs... box: a new dialogue box opens. Now select the item **H**istogram of data... . You should then click on **O**K to return to the main dialogue box and then click on **O**K again.

More complicated method

Click on **G**raph on the main Minitab menu and then click on **H**istogram.... When presented with the four thumbnails, click in the one headed 'Simple'. And then click **O**K. In the usual way, double-click on 'Ques1' in the lefthand box to place 'Ques1' in the **G**raph variables: box. Now click on **O**K.

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
